Agenda Contents

- (ii) be reported orally and presented in summary form by the Principal Officer of the Committee especially where representations are similar to, or repeat, previous submissions already contained in the agenda papers.

There are occasions when the number of representations are similar in nature and repeat the objections of others. In these cases it is not always possible for these to be included within the agenda papers. These are either summarised in the report (in terms of numbers received) and the main points highlighted or reported orally at the meeting. All documents are available as 'background papers' for public inspection.

Conduct

Members of the Public should note that the conduct of the meeting and the procedures followed are controlled by the Chairman of the Committee or, if he/she so decides, the Vice-Chairman. Any representations concerning Committee procedure or its conduct should be made in writing to either:

DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

You have a PERSONAL INTEREST in a matter being discussed at a meeting IF

- It relates to something on your Register of Interests form; or
- A decision on it would affect you, your family or friends more than other people in your Ward.

You have a PREJUDICIAL INTEREST in a matter being discussed at a meeting IF

- It affects your financial position or that of your family or friends more than other people in your Ward; or
- It concerns a planning or licensing application you or they have submitted
- AND IN EITHER CASE a reasonable member of the public would consider it to be so significant that you could not reach an unbiased decision.

If your interest is only PERSONAL, you must declare it but can still speak and vote. If your interest is PREJUDICIAL, you must leave the room. However, you have the same rights as a member of the public to address the meeting before leaving.

(a) <u>Application No. 06-13-0538-F - Two Bears Hotel, Pasteur Road,</u> 13 - 41 Cobholm

Demolition of hotel and replace with an A1 (Bulky Goods) unit with associated works.

(b) <u>Application No. 06-13-0472-O - Northgate Hospital, Northgate</u> 42 - 71

Street, Great Yarmouth

Demolition of two existing buildings and residential development of up to 79 units including of the Silverwood Centre and associated highway works.

(c) <u>Application No. 06-13-0559-F - Beach Road, Kiosk Site and</u> 72 - 101 <u>Land, Hemsby</u>

Convert existing retail kiosk site to provide a Takeaway Food kiosk (A5) with outdoor tables and chairs and convert adjacent land to Go-Kart Track.

(d) <u>Application No. 06-13-0600-F - 18 Copperfield Avenue, Great</u> 102 -Yarmouth 105

Proposed two storey extension to rear of existing house.

Proposed change of use from holiday lets to two residential dwellings.

(f) <u>Application No. 06-13-0569-F - The Hollies, High Road, Burgh</u> 111 -Castlo 115

Demolition of store and stable block and the erection of new garage block with storage over, together with retrospective application for changes to main house.
