**Personal or Local Non-Pecuniary Interests**

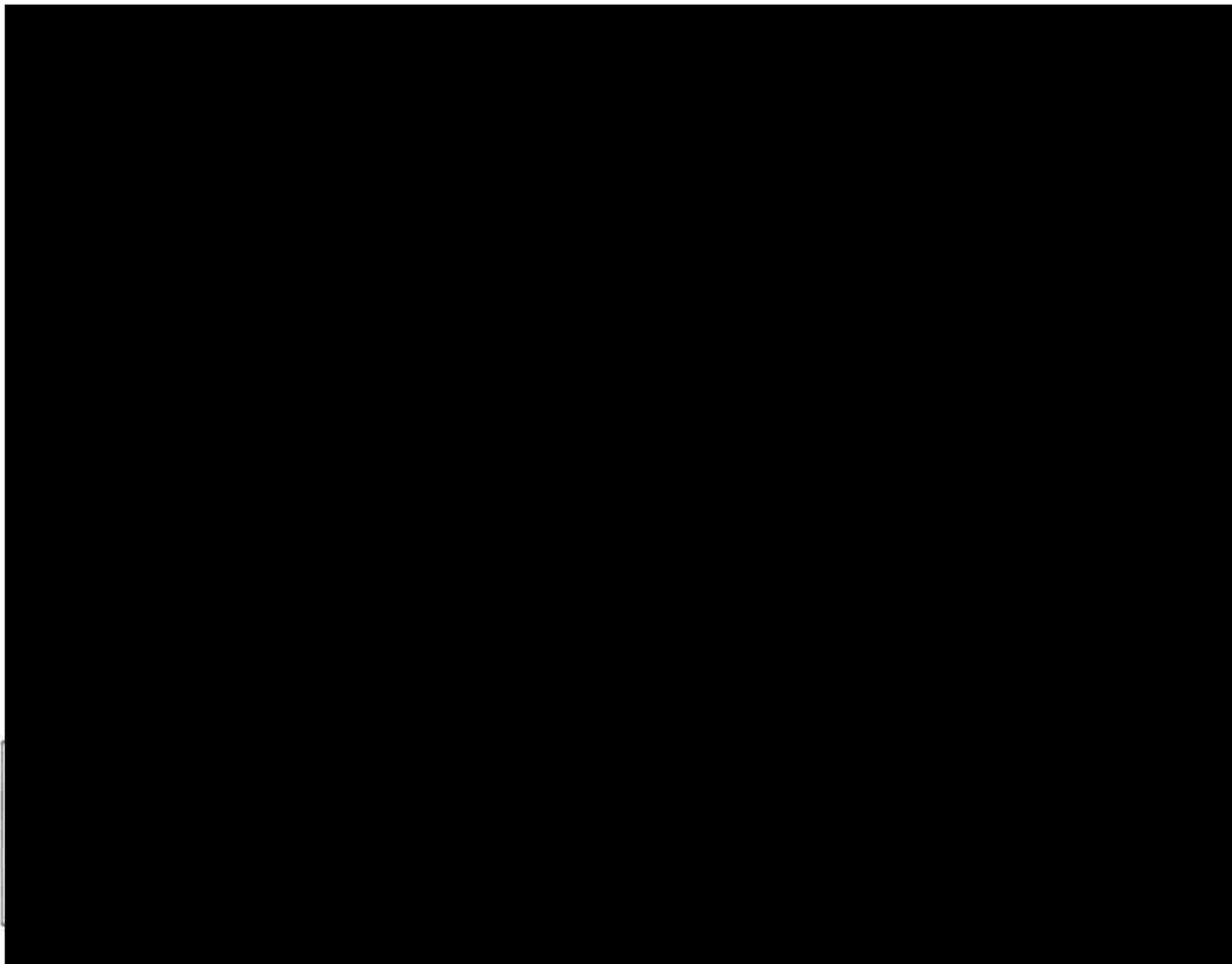

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I acknowledge that it may be an offence under the Localism Act 2011 to:-

- (1) omit information that ought to be given in this notice;
- (2) provide information that is materially false or misleading;
- (3) fail to give further notices in order to bring up to date information given in this notice after my re-election or reappointment or to fail to declare a disclosable pecuniary interest that I acquire after the date of this notice and have to declare under the provisions of s. 31 (2) Localism Act 2011.

I also acknowledge that it may be a breach of the Code of Conduct to:-

- (1) fail to notify the Monitoring Officer of any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests within 28 days of taking office by completing the register form.
- (2) omit information that ought to be given in this notice;
- (3) provide information that is materially false or misleading;
- (4) fail to provide written notification to the Council's Monitoring Officer of any change in my disclosable pecuniary interests as soon as possible.



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
