SUBJECT MATTER AND DECISION REQUIRED

The Licensing Sub-Committee is asked to consider the application for a new premises licence in relation to Florida Club, Back Market Lane, Hemsby, Great Yarmouth NR29 4HW

Recommendations:

It is recommended that the Sub-Committee determines the application for a new premises licence in accordance with one of the options set out in paragraph 4 below.

1. Application for a new premises licence

- 1.1 Members are asked to consider an application made by The Florida Club Hemsby Ltd for a new premises licence in relation to Florida Club, Back Market Lane, Hemsby, Great Yarmouth.
- 1.2 The premise is described as a holiday park club house, situated on the Florida holiday site. The premise has two bars and two main rooms, a dressing room for acts and a stage in both rooms plus use of an outdoor area.
- 1.3 Lisa Henry will be the designated premises supervisor for the premise.
- 1.4 The applicant has applied for the following licensable activities and timings: -

Supply of alcohol (on and off the premises): 11:00 to 02:00 (Mon – Sat), 11:00 to 00:00 (Sun)

Films: 12:00 to 23:00 each day

Live music (inside & out): 11:00 to 23:00 (Sun – Thur), 11:00 to 00:00 (Fri & Sat). Non standard timing: Christmas Eve – 1am close, New Years Eve – 2am close)

Recorded music (inside): 08:00 to 02:00 each day

Recorded music (outside): 10:00 to 22:00 each day

Performance of dance (inside & out): 11:00 to 23:00 (Sun – Thur), 11:00 to 00:00 (Fri & Sat)

Anything similar to live music, recorded music or dance: 11:00 to 23:00 (Sun – Thur), 11:00 to 00:00 (Fri & Sat)

Late night refreshment: 23:00 to 02:00 each day

2. Background information

- 2.1 The application was sent to the Responsible Authorities, advertised by notice at the premise and in a newspaper and detailed on the Council's website.
- 2.2 Upon expiry of the 28 day representation period, 10 valid representations objecting to the application were received and 21 representations in support of the application were received.
- 2.3 The Environmental Health Team also initially submitted a representation objecting to the application. This objection has subsequently been withdrawn due to the applicant agreeing to a number of conditions to be added to the operating schedule.






