1. Introduction

1.1. In May 2021 Council considered and agreed a report in respect of a review of Outside Bodies, this set out the way in which members who are appointed to outside bodies would report back to the Council on the activity of those organisations. The purpose of those reports is twofold – it is intended to provide the Council with an awareness and understanding of the current activity of the outside body and to understand how this aligns with the Council's corporate priorities; accordingly, this provides information for the Council to review (at Policy & Resources Committee) whether the appointment should continue

2.1. The members appointed to various Outside Bodies whose work is relevant to this Committee have provided an update on the past year's activity and this is summarised in the table below.
